

SOME ADVICE FOR YOU...

If your child is in KS2...

Get your child READING

- Reading has endless amount of benefits.
- Please encourage your child to be reading EVERY DAY.
- ESPECIALLY if your child struggles with spelling, reading can really help them.
- Get your child to read a variety of styles - books, newspapers, magazines, etc.
- Get your child to underline/highlight/write down words they don't understand
 - o This is so important!
 - o Get them to guess what they think it means given the context used
 - o Get them to research the definition/tell them yourself
 - o Ask them to use that word in a sentence of their own
 - o Test them later on to see if they remember



Keep an eye on your child's progress

- Ask school teachers for feedback
- Take note of your child's strongest and weakest subjects
- Read over your child's school or tutoring report
- Ask for help when they are struggling on a particular area if you are unsure how to address the issue

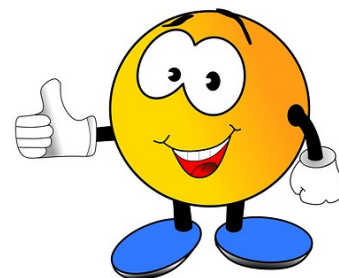


Ensure their work is kept organised

Positive encouragement

- While it can be good to be strict on your children, when learning, positive encouragement is really beneficial. Praise your child with a reward system so they feel proud of their work and want to succeed more.
